Well there is finally an effective, dependable treatment for your condition – VeinGogh. Telangectasia is a very common problem that develops from a range of factors, including age, hereditary, lifestyle and diet. These unsightly blemishes can appear on several visible areas including cheeks, chin, nose, ankles, knees and inner thighs. VeinGogh is the newest technology available for treating these benign vascular abnormalities.

How does it work?

The VeinGogh Ohmic Thermolysis System generates a tiny, regulated, high frequency current delivered to the vessel via a hair-thin probe. A “microburst” of energy selectively heats the vein, coagulating the blood and collapsing the vessel wall, which is quickly absorbed into the body. All this is accomplished without affecting the outer layers of the skin resulting in a quick return to normal daily activities.

Is there any downtime?

The precise nature of the VeinGogh treatment limits the risk of over-treating, so there is little to no trauma to the skin. Following treatment, there will be some mild redness that usually lasts about 1-2 hrs.

How long is a typical treatment?

Depending mainly on the size of the area, treatments can range from about a minute for minor lesions on the nose, and up to 20-25 minutes for a more extensive condition covering much of the face or legs.

When will I see results?

Immediately. You will see continuous improvement over several weeks as the treated vessels are reabsorbed.

How many treatments are needed?

Generally only one treatment is necessary. However depending on the specific condition, a follow-up treatment may be necessary.

Will the veins come back?

Veins that have been properly treated will not return. However, new veins may develop over time and require retreatment.

Does the treatment hurt?

On a pain scale of 1-10, with some laser treatments being an 8-9, VeinGogh is a 2-3. Since the procedure uses a hair-thin probe inserted into the vessel, there can be a slight “pinch”. Patients report it feels similar to a hair being removed.

VeinGogh works best on spider veins up to 0.3mm. VeinGogh is not designed to treat feeders or larger vessels deep beneath the surface. To effectively treat leg veins, VeinGogh should be used in conjunction with sclerotherapy.

Does VeinGogh only work on veins?

No! VeinGogh can also be used to eliminate cherry angiomas, small hemangiomas, skin tags, spider nevi, and even the redness of rosacea.

How much does this cost?

The treatment is sold in blocks of 5 minutes at a rate of \$120 for 5 minutes.

Commonly Asked Skin Care Questions

What is the difference between a treatment product and a moisturiser? A treatment product is a 'target' product. It is not a moisturiser but it is designed to combat specific conditions that your skin may be suffering from. You may not need any treatment products or you may need a couple depending on your skins conditions. Treatment products are designed to go under your moisturiser & target specific problems. Treatment products are generally stronger than moisturizers and will vary depending on your skin conditions. Only treatment products can target serious skin conditions, not a moisturiser. For example the Environ Clarifying serum is a treatment product targeting pigmentation, you would still need a moisturiser over the top of this product. Confused? Don't be just speak to one of our well trained therapists to help lead you in the right direction.

What is the difference between Night Cream & Day cream? Day cream is designed to protect your skin from damage by the elements and the often harsh environment of daily life. It protects your skin from moisture loss, sunlight (if it contains an SPF), maintains a protective barrier, & aids in healing the skin. Night creams are generally designed to repair and regenerate (not so much protect) your skin. As you sleep your skin is actually working away trying to combat what it has had to face during the day! You wouldn't need a moisturiser with an SPF such as Environ's RAD at night, save that one for the day and opt for a different night cream.

Do I really need to use a separate eye cream? The skin around the eyes is much finer and more delicate than the face and contains fewer sebaceous glands (oil glands). This is why it is more prone to drying out which leads to crows feet, fine lines and creepiness. Eye creams are specifically designed for this area, your normal moisturiser is too heavy and will clog the pores. It's never too early to start using an eye cream but definitely start from the age of 25-30 years up!
